

This is a privately owned cemetery, and is NOT associated with the Church nearby. The care and maintenance of this cemetery is handled privately, as well as the costs for same, and nobody is profiting from its existence except maybe those interred here. To keep this cemetery open to the public and allow a park-like atmosphere for all to experience and enjoy, the owner needs to ask that one SIMPLE RULE be established and followed, that is:

If YOU bring it into the cemetery, then YOU need to take it out of the cemetery!

What this means in simple terms is this; YOU take these items HOME with you, and YOU dispose of them there. All flowers and memorial items are allowed as long as YOU remove them in a timely manner after they have expired, typically within two months time. This will make the cemetery a beautiful place for all to enjoy, and will decrease the burden on the caretaker.
